#### A History Minute by Libby Putnam



In 1989, Mrs. Dot Haves organized a History Room in the Chapel on the second floor of the present educational building. When the 1905 church building was razed, there were many items of historical significance that were saved and those items became the basis of that History Room. The new History Room, open to all, is located to the left of the elevator on the second floor, but there are also some very important items in the first floor hallway next to the stairwell to the second floor. The quilt displayed there was the result of a fund raising project in 1935 by the women of the church. Women paid 10 cents to have family members names included on the quilt. Above the glass display case on the wall opposite the guilt is the Wall of Honor plaque listing the names of members of our church who had joined the military at the time of WWII. Ironically, some of the children whose names were embroidered on the guilt in 1935 are also found among the names of the young men and women defending our country just a few short years later. On top of the display case are photo albums with pictures from our history, and inside the case are items used in the 1905 church. The heritage of our church provides a firm foundation for us as we go day by day into the future.





KID Central, our new Children's Ministry program launched on June 2, 2019. KID Central meets at 8:45am on Sunday mornings and is facilitated by a core group of volunteers. We currently have 8 children that are attending weekly from ages 3 to 5th grade.


