
Itinerary

Directions from Kings Mtn/Shelby to Rankin Lake Picnic Area:

- 1. Take Hwy 74 East to I-85 North toward Gastonia, NC
- 2. Take the Exit for Hwy 321 N. Stay in Left Lane. Make a left at the Second Traffic like onto Rankin Lake Road.
- When Entering Rankin Lake Park stay to the right and take the paved road to the right up the hill to Picnic Shelter #6 which has limited parking around it and is overlooking the playground.














Please Note: There is limited parking next to Shelter #6. Park in the main parking area if you can walk further.
