

To all my people—Good Day. I missed writing to you in June. So many praises and prayers have happened since May. God is Good.

My daughter, Kalin, wanted to go to the Ark Encounter in Williamstown, Kentucky, for her graduation, and we turned it into a great family vacation. The Ark Encounter was our first stop. I widened my eyes to take it all in, and seeing the Ark up close overwhelmed me with Amazement.

As we went through the Ark, I felt like I was taking one verse from a book in the Bible and doing a "Deep Dive," trying to understand all the parts and pieces.
