

### A History Minute by Libby Putnam








While hurrying through the hallway from the CAC, through the Educational Building, and on to the Sanctuary, have you ever stopped to look at the items in the glass case next to the stairs leading to the second floor of the Educational Building? Inside of that case, which was a gift to our church from member Jane Campbell Kiser, you will see several items used in our "old" sanctuary built in 1905. Not only are there copies of old Methodist hymnals, but there are also copies of song books especially for the children and youth as well as the old bell which was rung to announce the end of the Sunday School hour. On the bottom shelf of the glass case there two communion trays used in the old sanctuary, and the brass cross and candle holders on the top of the case were used in the chapel on the second floor of the Education Building. Above the case is the Roll of Honor listing the names of those young men from Central serving in the Armed Forces during World War II. Hanging on the facing wall is the guilt project of the Women of the Church completed in 1935. The 236 names embroidered on the guilt each represent not only a donation to the church of 10 cents or more, but also a labor of love and time to complete such a loving tribute to our church.

In the coming months, keep check on the area we can dub the History Corner. Plans are to replace the items listed above and rotate interesting items currently stored in the History Room that can give us a picture of activities at Central during the 148 years since our church was founded.
