A History Minute by Libby Putnam



On October 11, 1977, the women of Central United Methodist Church held a Taste Fair inviting the community to taste recipes from the South, Cajun Country, Pennsylvania Dutch Country, and the West. Recipes collected from members of our church were prepared to be sampled by those attending the Fair. A cookbook, illustrated by Mary Wade Smith, contained all of the recipes prepared for the event. With Thanksgiving approaching, perhaps this recipe from the Pennsylvania Dutch section of the cookbook could take center stage on your holiday table.



PIGS KNUCKLES and SAUERKRAUT WITH CARAWAY DUMPLINGS

1-1/2 qts. sauerkraut 6 pigs knuckles, fresh or canned 1 onion, chopped

1 c. water

* Caraway Dumpling Batter

Put sauerkraut and pigs knuckles into a kettle.
Sprinkle with chopped onion. Add water and simmer covered until tender, about 2-1/2 hours.
Drop Caraway Dumpling Batter by tablespoonful on top. Cover and cook for 15 minutes. (Small chunks of green pork or pork chops may be substituted for the knuckles.)





*CARAWAY DUMPLING BATTER

1-1/2 c. sifted all-purpose flour 1 egg, beaten 1 tsp. baking powder 1/3 c. water 1/2 tsp. salt 2 Tbs. butter or margarine, melted 1 tsp. sugar 1 Tbs. caraway seeds

Mix dry ingredients. Add combined egg and melted butter.

Mix until dry ingredients are moistened. Stir in caraway seeds.
