
Methodist Women of Kings Mountain Host: Mercy House Global "Share The Light" Event Saturday, February 10, 2024

A History Minute by Libby Putnam



Throughout the history of the church, music has played not only a huge part in our worship services but in our times of fellowship and learning as well. Working with the children and youth in Sunday School and other activities, the songs we sing teach us not only about the life of Jesus, but they help to reinforce the core beliefs of our faith. Music is such an important teaching tool that throughout the history of Central care was taken to be sure age-specific music books were available and ready to be used. Many of those special collections of songs can be found in the History Room.

"Go, Sing It On The Mountain" was a collection of hymns, spirituals, folk songs, and fun songs for use at camps and youth assemblies. The Conference MYF Council in 1953 authorized the publication of this book especially for use in the Western North Carolina Conference. The first song in the book was a favorite of many, "Go, Tell It On the Mountain."

Dating back a few years earlier we find "The Young People's Hymnal" which was published in 1912 with songs adapted to the use of Sunday Schools, Epworth Leagues, Prayer Meetings and Revivals. Perhaps you might recognize one of the rousing hymns in the collection, "Throw Out the Lifeline."

Whether today or in the past, the songs we sing inspire us to follow Christ's teachings, and singing is a fun way to learn those lessons.
