There will be a **Trustees Meeting** on Monday, **May 4, 2026**, at 6:00 pm.

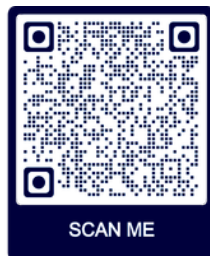

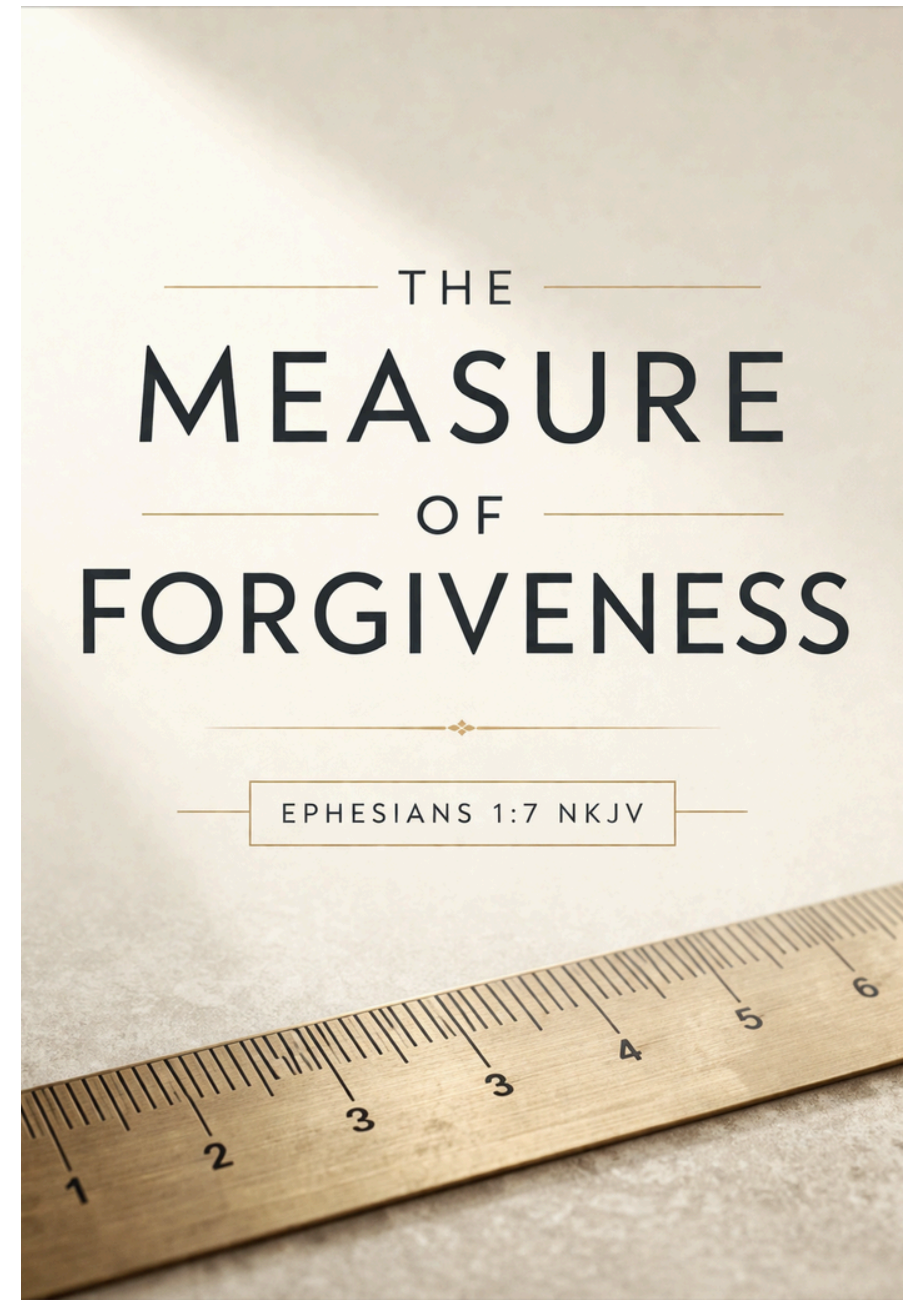
